On October 25 and 26, the Coupe de France CNR returns to Vichy!



THE VENUE

Lac d'Allier, situated in Vichy, France, is a prominent venue for aquatic sports and leisure activities. The lake features a 2.5 km by 200 m zone along the left bank, equipped with sound systems, adjacent to parks and the city centers of Vichy and Bellerive-sur-Allier.

An illuminated promenade along the waterfront allows spectators to follow athletes by bicycle. Facilities include a 2,000 m² hall for rowing storage, and a judges' tower for timing and officiating teams.

The venue has hosted major international competitions, including World Championships, confirming its status as a world-class regatta course.

TRANSPORT

Vichy is easily accessible by various means of transport:

• By Train: You can take a TER or Intercités train from cities like Lyon, Clermont-Ferrand, or Paris. The journey from Lyon takes about 2 hours, and trains arrive at Vichy's main train station, located near the city center.

By Car: Vichy is connected by major highways, including the A89 and A719. From Lyon, it takes around 2 hours by car. Driving gives you the flexibility to explore the surrounding area.

By Plane: The nearest major airport is Lyon-Saint-Exupéry (LYS), located about 170 km from Vichy. The journey takes around 2h30 by car or 3h30 by train with a transfer in Lyon.



Centralized Accommodation and Meals Service

Vichy Sport offers a dedicated service to help teams simplify the organization of their stay during the Coupe de France CNR 2025. This service provides the opportunity to centralize the management of both accommodation and meals, ensuring a smooth and coordinated experience for all participants.
